

London CONTEST Board Meeting Note

9 July 2018

The London CONTEST Board meeting of 9 July 2018 was chaired by the Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime. The Board is made up of members from MOPAC, MPS, Home Office, NHS England, City of London, National Probation Service (NPS), TfL and London Councils.

Agenda Item 1: Actions. The outstanding matters were addressed.

Agenda Item 2: Pursue. The Board was provided with a current threat briefing and additional information recent terror related court cases.

Agenda Item 3: Stand alone items. The Board heard presentations on Local Authority Prevent Project Portfolio; CONTEST Strategy; Multi-Agency Centres; Counter Terrorism and Border Security Bill and the DfE consultation on Elective Home Education.

Agenda Item 4: Prevent. There was an update from the London Prevent Board and a presentation on the Countering Violent Extremism Programme.

Agenda Item 5: Protect. The Board heard an update on Hostile Vehicle Mitigation and the coordination of communications to Authorities on crowded spaces.

Agenda Item 6: Prepare. The Board heard updates on the prepare strand and the work of the London Resilience Forum.
